



# Pets at Mystwood



Yes we are pet friendly and love to have your fur babies attend your wedding, but we do need a little info from you before we can approve their attendance.

Please let us know the following:

1. What breed of dog/s?
2. How many dog/s?
3. How old?
4. Toilet trained?
5. Friendly to all people?
6. Will they just be coming to the ceremony or staying in the cabin with you?
7. Are they barking dogs?
8. Who will be supervising them while at the wedding?
9. A photo of your fur baby/babies.

## Other things to consider

- If your fur baby is in your cabin unattended they must not be on the bed or any furniture.
  - They must be on a leash at all times with no exception.
- We are very much in the country and there are spiders, snakes, foxes and other wildlife so you must take care that they do not run off or go underneath cabins and into areas where snakes may be hiding. If your fur baby gets bitten by a snake, the outcome will not be good.
  - There is a charge of \$100 per fur baby if approved to stay at the cabins.
- There is a \$200 bond for your cabin which will be returned provided your fur baby does not urinate or poop in the cabin or destroy any furniture or items. If damage exceeds the \$200 bond, you will be liable for all additional costs to repair or deep clean the cabin.
  - You must pick up all fur baby poop.
- If your fur babies are only attending the wedding and not staying, there is no charge.
  - You will be asked to sign a waiver stating that you are responsible for your fur baby/babies for the entire time they are on the property. Should your fur baby cause any harm to any guest or any other animal on the property being domestic or wildlife you will be responsible for any repercussions as the owner.
  - You will need to provide us with information such as their micro chip certificate and evidence that their vaccinations are up to date. You must also provide evidence that your fur baby has had their current tick and flea treatment as one tick can kill your loved one and we cannot risk having fleas in the cabins or at the venue.
